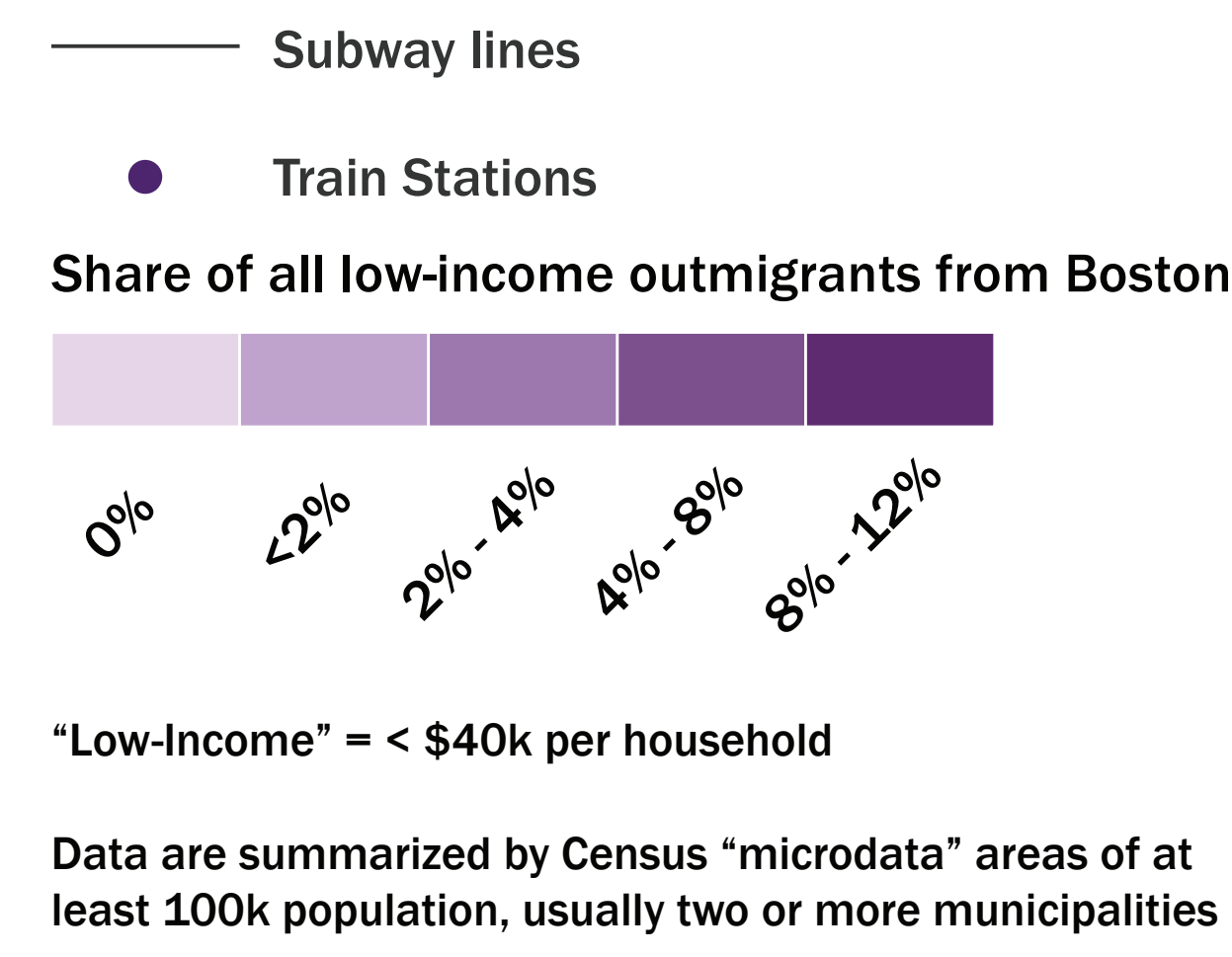
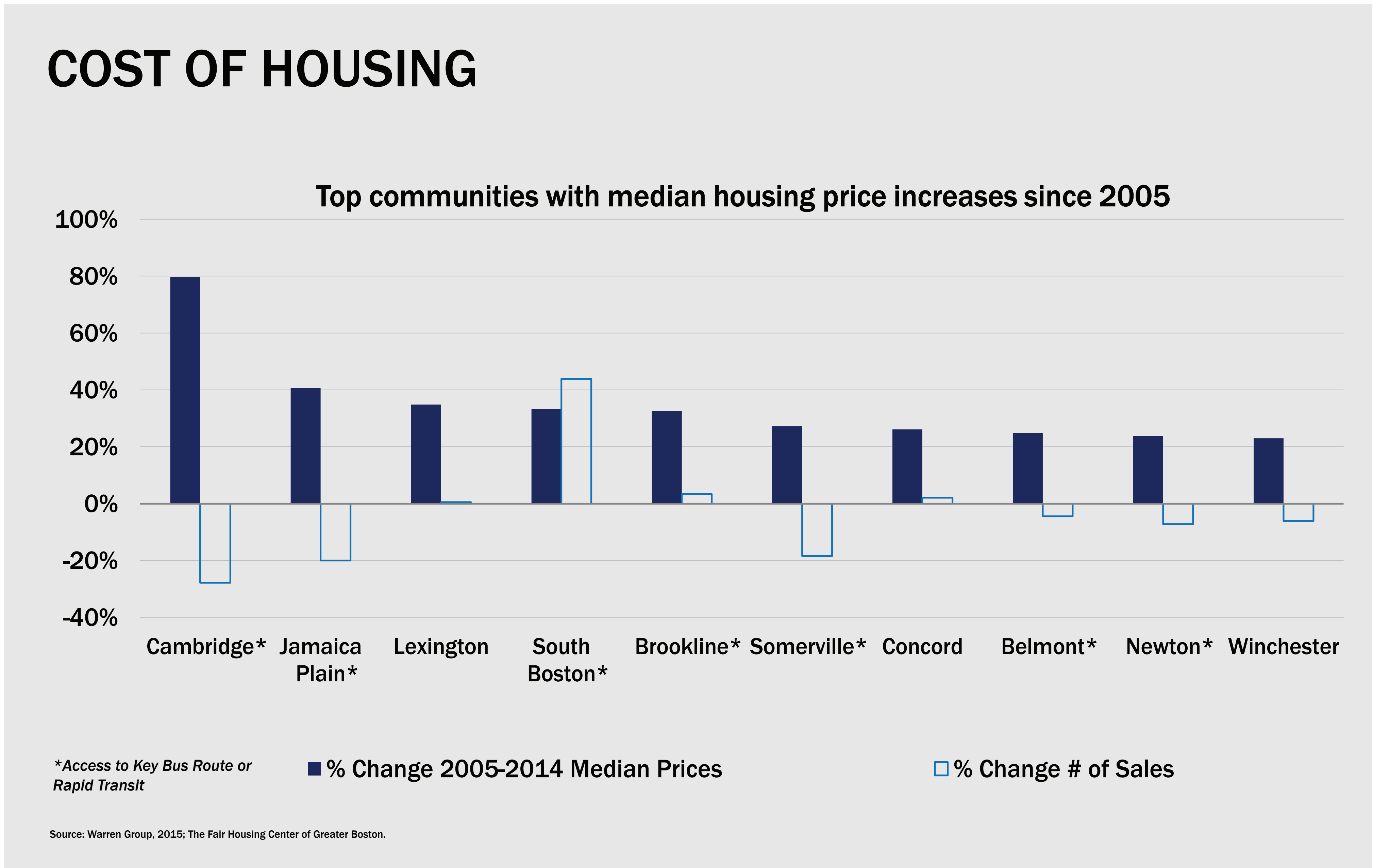
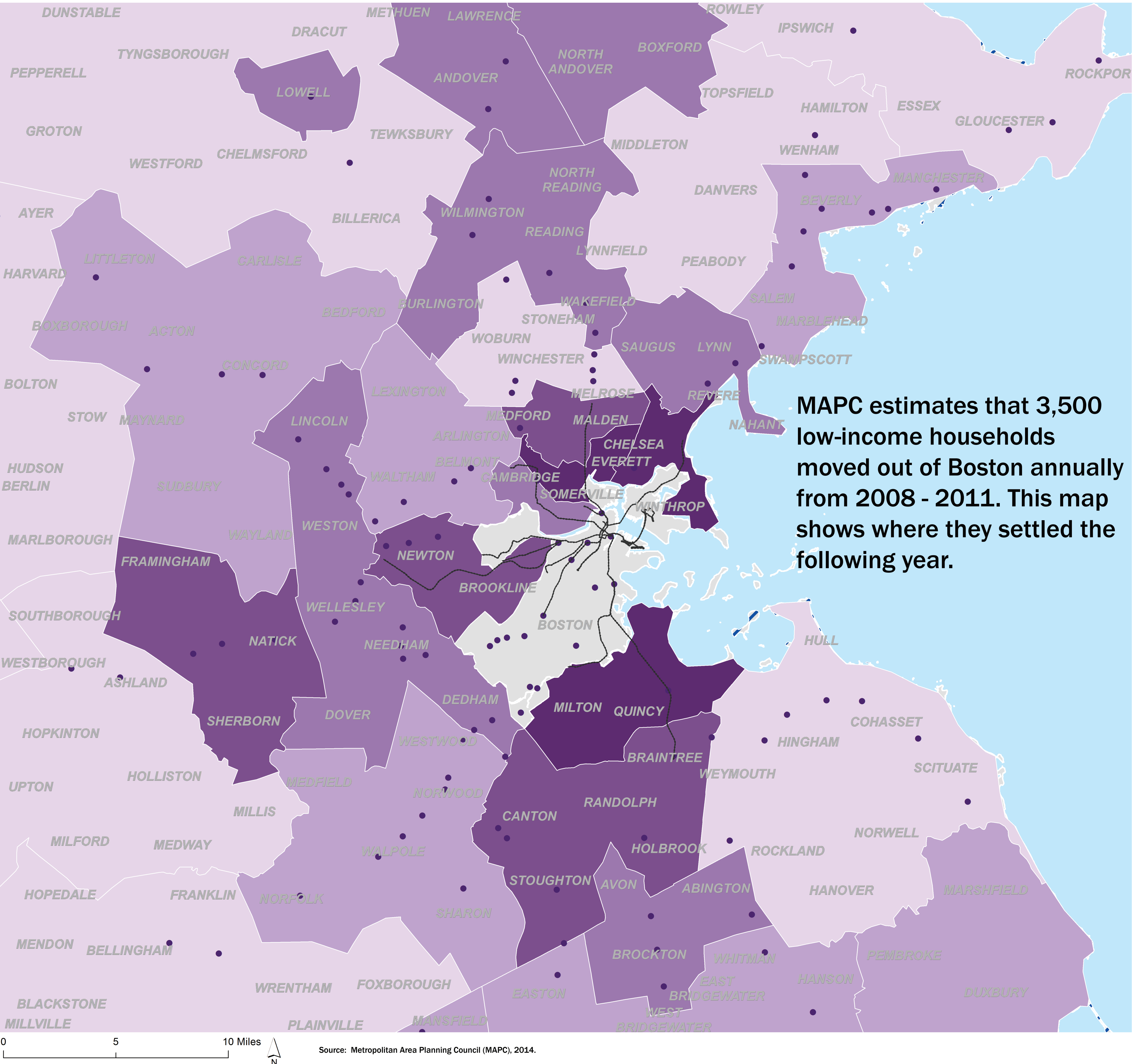


DEMOGRAPHIC SHIFTS

RIISING COST OF HOUSING COULD MEAN

AREAS LESS WELL-SERVED BY THE T



Although transportation costs can be lower in the core (without the need for multiple cars per household), housing costs have been increasing, resulting in a greater rent burden and some displacement to areas less well-served by transit.
