SERVICE ISSUES

- Rapid transit ridership has been growing, and planned development along these corridors suggests growth will continue
- Providing additional capacity requires systemwide upgrades to many asset classes including stations, facilities, power and signals

CAPITAL ASSET ISSUES

- Red and Green Line fleets more prone to failure than other lines
- Power upgrades are necessary to provide consistent 3-car service on Green Line
- Signal assets require systemwide modernization to increase capacity and frequency of service
